Optimal Mirror Work and Positioning for Microscopic Dentistry Hiroki Isozaki

The microscope is a tool for visual enhancement, and its effectiveness is already widely known and becoming more common in dentistry. However, not all parts of the oral cavity can be seen in detail as long as we have a microscope, and use of dental mirrors are essential skill in dentistry because centrifugal surfaces and proximal intraoral walls couldn't be seen without mirror. Although the use of dental mirrors is essential skill in dentistry, no systematic education has been provided at any university.

Until American dentist Daryl Beach systematized the use of dental mirrors as a systematic view, it was a matter of personal experience and difficult to transfer the technology. The lecturers believe that the systematic view is an essential technique for microscopic dentistry and have been conducting seminars to transfer the technique. With the cooperation of JAMD, we have decided to hold a hands-on seminar.

This hands-on seminar is a must-attend event for anyone who wants to become a microscopic dentist, as systematic view is the most powerful technique to improve treatment with microscope to several levels, from beginners to veterans.
